Money Minute - May 21, 2017

Hello! And thank you for this opportunity to speak to you as the new Stewardship chair. As I thought about what I wanted to do as Stewardship chair, the first thing that came to mind was that we don't have enough conversations around money in this church. So, I decided we needed to have a monthly conversation about it! This was to be the first of such talks. I was more or less prepared to go down the path of budgets and expenses and pledge numbers and so on. But then, as part of a leadership training course, I came across a Ted talk by Simon Sinek called "How great leaders inspire action" and it completely changed my plans.

To give you a quick summary of what he presented: He talks about something called the golden circle. Imagine three concentric circles with "What" in the outermost circle, "How" in the middle circle, and "Why" in the innermost circle. Sinek says most people and companies talk about the *What* followed by the *How*, whereas great leaders lead with the *Why* and then talk about the *How* and the *What*.

To give you an example, let's compare what Apple does that is different from, say, a company like HP.

HP says, "We make great computers. They're beautifully designed, simple to use, and user friendly. Wanna buy some?" Mmm. Meh.

Apple, on the other hand, says, "In everything we do, we believe in challenging the status quo. We believe in thinking differently. The way we do this is by making products that are beautifully designed, simple to use, and user friendly. We just happen to make great computers, and iPhones and iPods. Wanna buy some?" Absolutely!

So, today, I want to focus on the "why we do what we do." We, Sunnyhill, are like the beacon on top of the hill! Look around you today. These are challenging times. The very foundation of who we are as a people is at stake. People are being targeted for who they are, what they believe, who they love, or who they identify as! Income inequality is off the charts!
